

Anglers Habitat Derby for Kids on



- **Rules**

- The Derby will occur between 2pm and 4pm on April 26th, 2008. Registrations will be limited to children age 13 or younger. Children of this age group do not need Idaho fishing licenses.
- **The landscaping is NEW.** Please stay off the seeded grass areas and use the sod areas or paved walks only. Each registered fisher will have a designated area to fish from, which will be changed once during the derby.
- All people must register for the derby before 6pm April 24th. **All registered children will be accompanied by an adult.**
- The Derby site will be between the Kimball St. Gazebo and the 5th Street bridge in front of the Police Station. Instructions on fishing site placement will be handed out at the check-in table on Derby Day – April 26.
- A drawing will be held at **Anglers Habitat** for Creekside positions on Friday April 25th. The section drawn will be the starting position each fisher will begin fishing at 2:00pm, April 26th. If more than one child in a family is registered, we will endeavor to keep all of a single family in adjoining sections.
- **Each fisher is responsible for cleaning up the section they from which they fish.** Trash receptacles will be provided in convenient locations along the course of the creek.
- For those who wish to catch and release, a live tub will be provided to keep the fish for measurement and counting. Monitors will circulate along the creek and record those fish caught before returning them to the creek. Fish caught multiple times will add to your total.
- Kids will be fishing in close proximity to each other, both adjacent as well as across the creek. They will also be fishing in front of observers, parents and others and will need to be aware of where their hooks are going. Please remember that **GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP** and **SAFETY** prevails. This is a **FUN** event and a chance for adults cheer and teach children.
